The Electromagnetic Compatibility Laboratory (EMC Lab) has received an accreditation from National Accreditation Board for Testing and Calibration Laboratories (NABL) in accordance with ISO/IEC 17025:2017 in the discipline of 'Electrical Testing'. With this accreditation, ITI can support manufacturers and product designers by detecting the slightest anomalies in the electromagnetic and electrical operations of their products and address frequent due diligence, compliance and market access challenges. Electromagnetic Compatibility (EMC) testing measures the ability of equipment or systems to function satisfactorily in their electromagnetic environment without introducing intolerable electromagnetic disturbance to anything in that environment.
