निगमित कार्यालय की राजभाषा कार्यान्वयन समिति की बैठक में समिति सदस्यों द्वारा लिए गए निर्णय

दिनांक 26.12.2019 को अध्यक्ष एवं प्रबंध निदेशक की अध्यक्षता में संपन्न निगमित कार्यालय के राजभाषा कार्यान्वयन समिति की बैठक में समिति सदस्य श्री शिश प्रकाश गुप्ता, निदेशक-मा.सं. द्वारा सभी अधीनस्थ इकाई एवं एमएसपी प्रमुखों को राजभाषा नीति का अपने कार्यालय में अक्षरशः अनुपालन हेतु आवश्यक निदेश प्रदान किए गए:

- उन्होंने कहा कि सरकारी कामकाज में हिंदी के प्रयोग में प्रगति हुई है, लेकिन अब भी हम मंत्रालय द्वारा निर्धारित किए लक्ष्यों को प्राप्त नहीं कर पाएं हैं । उन्होंने अवगत कराया कि माननीय सांसदों द्वारा संसद प्रश्न के संबंध में चर्चा के दौरान भी यह मामला लोक सभा में उठाया गया है कि स्वतंत्रता प्राप्ति के 70 वर्षों के पश्चात् भी हिंदी में सरकारी कामकाज अपेक्षा से कम है । संविधान की मूल भावना एवं भारत सरकार की राजभाषा नीति के अनुसार यह अपेक्षित है कि सरकारी कामकाज अधिक-से-अधिक राजभाषा हिंदी में ही किए जाएं ।
- समस्त इकाई एवं एमएसपी कार्यालयों से प्राप्त जुलाई-सितंबर, 2019 की तिमाही प्रगति रिपोर्ट की समीक्षा उपरांत् समिति सदस्यों ने पाया कि सभी इकाई एवं क्षेत्रीय कार्यालयों के हिंदी पत्राचार की प्रतिशतता मंत्रालय द्वारा निर्धारित किए गए प्रतिशतता से बहुत ही कम है । उन्होंने कहा कि इस दिशा में हमें यह सुनिश्चित करना है कि विभिन्न क्षेत्रों से विभिन्न उपक्रमों/संस्थाओं द्वारा किए जाने/भेजे जाने वाले पत्राचार केवल हिंदी में ही किए जाएं और आवश्यकता पड़ने पर उसे द्विभाषी रुप प्रदान कर भेजे जाएं ।
- समिति सदस्यों द्वारा यह भी निदेश प्रदान किया गया कि समस्त इकाई एवं एमएसपी कार्यालयों में प्रयोग किए जाने वाले / उपलब्ध सभी मानक प्रारुप (Standard-Format) द्विभाषी रुप में उपलब्ध हों, यदि द्विभाषी नहीं हैं तो उसे शीघ्र ही द्विभाषी किया जाए ।
- सिमिति सदस्यों द्वारा समस्त इकाई एवं एमएसपी प्रमुखों से यह भी सुनिश्चित करने को कहा गया कि, भारत सरकार, गृह मंत्रालय द्वारा जारी
 दिशा-निर्देशों के अंतर्गत समस्त कार्यालयों में प्रयोग किए जा रहे कंम्प्यूटरों एवं लैपटॉप आवश्यक रुप से 'हिंदी यूनिकोड मंगल फोंट' में
 द्विभाषी हों ।
- बैठक के दौरान समिति सदस्यों ने आईटीआई लिमिटेड के समस्त विष्ठ अधिकारियों से अपील की कि सरकारी कामकाज को मूल रूप से हिंदी में करने के लिए आवश्यक है कि हम स्वंय अपना कार्य हिंदी में करें एवं इसकी पहल हिंदी हस्ताक्षर से करें । विष्ठ अधिकारियों द्वारा हिंदी में किए गए पत्राचार, अधीनस्थ अधिकारियों के लिए एक उदाहरण साबित होगा और उन्हें हिंदी में कार्य करने की प्रेरणा मिलेगी तथा इससे हिंदी में पत्राचार का लक्ष्य प्राप्त करने में भी सहायता मिलेगी । चूंकि राजभाषा नियम-1976 के नियम 12 के अनुसार प्रत्येक कार्यालय के प्रशासिनक प्रधान का यह उत्तरदायित्व है कि वह यह सुनिश्चित करें कि उक्त अधिनियमों/नियमों तथा भारत सरकार द्वारा समय-समय पर जारी किए गए दिशा-निर्देशों का समुचित रूप से अपने इकाईयों/कार्यालयों में अनुपालन हो रहा है अथवा नहीं ।
