This EVM can also be used as a single-post machine for meeting the requirements of Lok Sabha/Assembly polls.

जरूरतों को पूरा करने के लिए सिंगल पोस्ट मशीन के रूप में भी किया जा सकता है।

फास्ट-ट्रैक आधार पर होगी डिलिवरी
