DAYS after India made it mandatory to seek licence for import of laptops and personal computers (PC), state-owned ITI Limited has claimed it has developed its own brand of laptop and micro PC for domestic market.

The company, which offers a complete range of telecom products, claims that its products --branded as SMAASH -- can match international quality and performance standards. Products from the Bangalore-based public sector company are already available in the market, and the company has successfully won many tenders, competing against MNC brands such as Acer, HP, Dell, and Lenovo.

"The flagship products - Laptop and Micro PC - have been designed in association with Intel Corporation with which an MoU has been signed for design and manufacturing," said a company statement. After the announcement, share price of the company rose from ₹125 level in the afternoon to close the day on Monday at ₹149.30, up 20% from the previous day's closing. 

Laptop deal with Intel lifts ITI stock 33% in two days

In a striking departure from the overall market trend, the share price of public sector undertaking ITI Limited has risen by 33 per cent in two days, adding over ₹4,000 crore in m-cap, after announcing a major partnership with Intel for the production of laptops and micro PCs.

The stock went up by 20 per cent on Monday when the pact with Intel was announced, and by another 11.4 per cent on Tuesday, recording a fresh 52-week high of ₹176.90. The stock closed at ₹166.45, up 11.41 per cent.

The company announced the launch of its proprietary laptops and micro-PCs under the brand name SMAASH. As a result, the company's scrip closed at a 52-week high of ₹149.40 on the exchange board on Monday, compared to Friday's closing of ₹124.50.

The design and manufacturing of two flagship products — laptop and micro-PC — will be done in association with Intel Corporation, the company said in a release.

Additionally, the PSU recently won two tenders from KITE (Kerala Infrastructure and Technology) for the supply of around 9,000 laptops to government schools in Kerala.

ITI is a telecom company and multi-unit central public sector undertaking. The company has manufacturing facilities in six locations (Bengaluru, Naini, Raebareli, Mankapur, Srinagar and Palakkad) along with an inhouse R&D centre in Bengaluru.

In FY23, ITI recorded ₹1,395 crore topline but posted a loss of ₹360 crore due to higher expenses.
